FINANCIALS - AUDIT, RISK & COMPLIANCE

The Audit, Risk and Compliance Committee (ARCC) was convened in February 2018. Following Megan McKenna's resignation, the ARCC now consists of:

The purpose of the ARCC is to govern the audit function, financial reporting function, the risk assessment, response, and compliance performance of the Functions, and assets of the Rangitane o Wairau Group.

> With Leigh stepping down from the Trust board, the trust board position will need to be filled in the near future.



FINANCIALS - ACCOUNTANTS REPORT

Financial Performance

- Operating surplus of \$321k (prior year surplus \$207k)
 While Revenue remains consistent, costs have been significantly reduced.
- 2. Dividend and interest income \$640k (prior year \$388k).
- 3. Fair Value Increases:

a. Investment Properties	\$1.4m increase	
b. Quota	\$88k increase	
c. Shares	\$742k increase	

- The above assets have been revalued consistent with prior periods.
- 5. Aquaculture Settlement Funds were received of \$4.8m.



FINANCIALS - ACCOUNTANTS REPORT

Statement of Financial Position

- 1. Total Assets now \$70.3m
- 2. Total Liabilities now \$0.6m
- 3. Total Trust Funds now \$69.7m

FINANCIALS - AUDITORS REPORT

- 1. BDO were appointed as auditors in 2018 and 2019 was our second year as auditor of Rangitane.
- BDO audit the financial statements of each entity as requested by the Trustees
 - No specific additional audit work was undertaken
 - There were no changes in accounting policies.
 - The Trust and Group opinions were issued on 2 August 2019
 - They are all "clean" and unqualified
